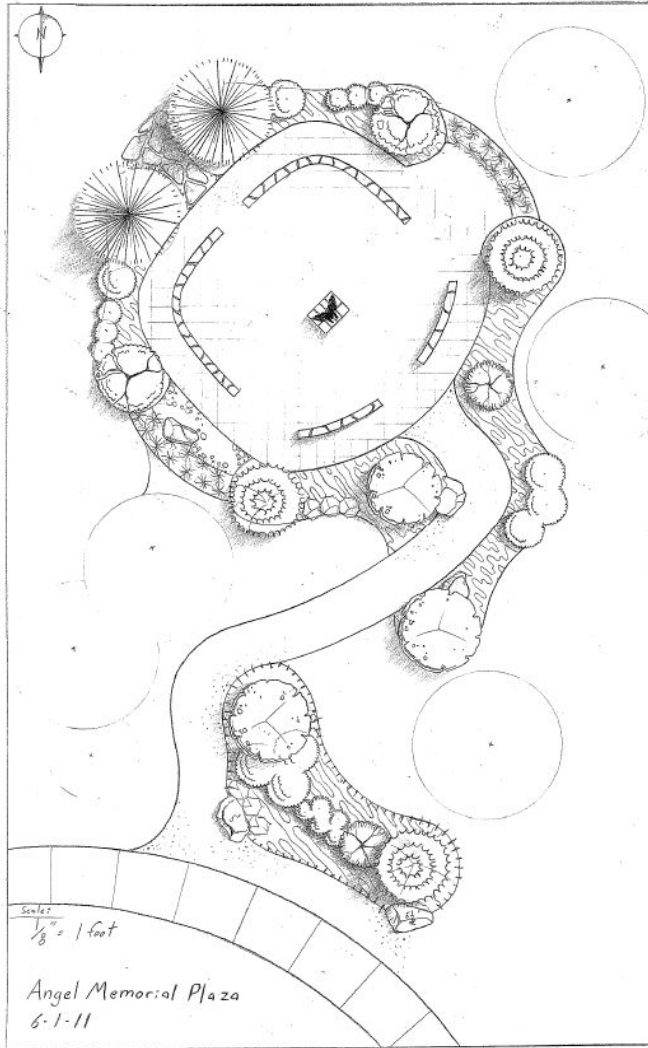




## 2011 Angel Memorial Plaza • Landscaping Project •

We are so excited to announce that the Town of Parker Public Works Department has approved a landscaping plan for our RTF Angel Memorial Plaza.



It all started when an Eagle Scout candidate approached us asking if we might be in need of some help sprucing up the memorial plaza with some plantings and landscaping as a potential community service project to earn his Eagle with the Boy Scouts of America.

The town of Parker Public Works Department was more than happy to assist us with the development of a plan to landscape the Memorial Plaza in two segments.

A portion of this project (the lower segment of the design pictured, near the paved path) will be funded and completed as part of the Eagle Scout project. The rest is up to us.

**The Public Works Department has generously agreed to donate all the labor and design work for the project, so we are responsible only for the materials and the cost of an outside cement contractor.**

**The estimated retail cost for this project is \$25,000.**
